We're especially looking for motivated individuals willing to help us with marketing and fundraising for our next two homes. The volunteer Fundraising/Marketing team needs a chairperson to help plan fundraising campaigns, and represent the team at board meetings.

**Experience is not a requirement - committee chairs are team representatives. These are learning roles.**
